The Riverside Resort has 35 acres of fields, lawns and forest on the Saint John River with walking trails, a boat launch and docks. Located along the banks of the beautiful St. John River between the show site and Fredericton this full service campground is being completely renovated and features an on-site Water Activity Park and many other amenities.

Best known as an Earthdog judge and proponent of the breed in the field, JoAnn judged the Border Terrier Club of America Sweepstakes in 1999 and we are thrilled that she has agreed to step back in the ring for our National Specialty. **Patrick Glover** (Greywoode Border Terriers) is our Specialty Conformation judge. He is a breeder judge with more than 30 years in the breed and a profound respect for the working qualities of the breed. Our own **Rosemary Shoreman** will be judging Junior Showmanship and our Earthdog judge is **Judy Todd**, a familiar face to Earthdog enthusiasts in the US and Eastern Canada. Veteran and puppy sweeps will be on Wednesday morning with Earthdog (Intro thru Senior) in the afternoon. and a BBQ on the deck overlooking the river in the evening. The Specialty regular and non-regular classes and junior showmanship will take place on Thursday followed by the AGM with a buffet/banquet and silent auction in the evening.

The Fredericton Kennel Club is planning three conformation shows on July 27, 28 and 29 at the Tri-County Complex Center in Fredericton Junction, about an hour's drive from Riverside Resort. In addition, River Valley Obedience & Field Trial Club will be holding obedience and rally trials on July 28-29 in downtown Fredericton approximately 30 minutes from our site.

Getting there can be half the fun! Fredericton is readily accessible from all the Atlantic Provinces, Quebec, Ontario, New England and New York State. Travel with a buddy and enjoy the beautiful vistas along the way. For those who absolutely cannot take advantage of a scenic road trip, there are connecting flights through Montreal and Toronto into Fredericton International Airport, or consider flying into Bangor, ME, a pleasant 2-1/2 hour drive from the site.
